



Safety Policy

For the safety of our staff and visiting family members we ask you to follow the list of actions and items that are not permitted on the grounds of Rose Hill Burial Park. Failure to do so will result in us removing these items and discarding them. Rose Hill Burial Park will not hold or collect for retrieval those items not permitted in these guidelines. All of these actions and items pose a serious risk of injury to our workers and visitors and we thank you for your cooperation.

No items are permitted to hang from the surrounding trees, bushes or landscaped features including but not limited to; holiday ornaments, streamers, wind chimes, birdhouses or feeders, glass items, dream catchers, etc.

Placing non-floral, stand-alone decorations such as balloons, pinwheels, shepherd's hooks, placards of any type, statues, toys, trinkets, stuffed animals, grave blankets, homemade monuments, garden or stepping stones or any other items pushed into the ground or hung from a branch will not be allowed.

No attachments of any kind will be allowed on permanent memorials or mausoleum crypt fronts.

The cemetery shall not be responsible for lost, stolen, damaged, missing items or floral arrangements due to extreme weather, theft or policy enforcement.

Policy is subject to change without notice and at the discretion of Rose Hill Burial Park.

Please refer to our safety policy or one of family service representatives for clarification of your desired arrangement.

Burial Park and Mausoleum Clean-up Days

February 1st:

Park clean up and turf treatments. Please remove all decorations prior to February 1.

We will remove all decorations for a complete cleanup so that we can begin our turf treatments. Weather determines when we can finish cleanup and apply these treatments so we are asking for a large time window. Once a section has been cleaned it is safe to put flowers in vases only.

Holidays

Easter, Mother's Day and Father's Day:

Decorations are permitted from 5pm Friday until sundown the following Sunday.

Memorial Day:

Decorations are permitted from 5pm Friday until sundown the following Sunday after Memorial Day.

Halloween and Thanksgiving:

Decorations are permitted 3 days prior through 3 days after the holiday.

Christmas:

Decorations are permitted December 1 through January 31st.

Sanctuary Rose Mausoleum:

When placing arrangements please be mindful of the limited space within and around the Sanctuary Rose Mausoleum. While we encourage memorial flower arrangements, we ask that you place only one floral arrangement per loved one on the tables provided. In the event you leave any items other than fresh cut or artificial floral arrangements, they will be removed as we cannot be held responsible for items of value left in the public spaces in or around the mausoleum. Thank you for helping us keep this a sacred and special area of Rose Hill Burial Park.

- We will provide tables for displays as near as possible but suitable vases or containers must be provided by the donor.
- If cut flowers are used, we suggest you have the florist place the stems in water tubes. This will help the flowers to last longer and also protect the carpet from spills.
- The size of all arrangements must be suitable and within a general scheme of good taste.
- Fresh flowers or live plants may be arranged or used at any times. We will remove them when needed.
